


## Firmware Upgrade

Here you can view the current version of the firmware of your TripMate





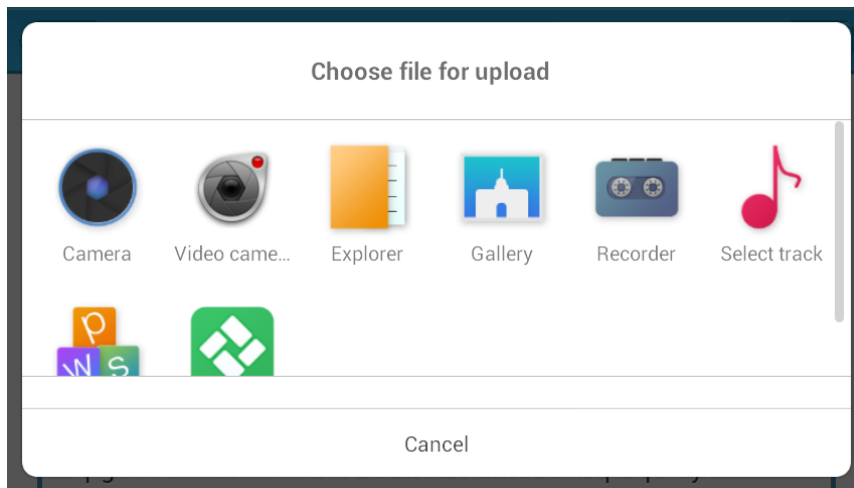
### **The First Way:**

To upgrade the firmware, please follow the steps below:

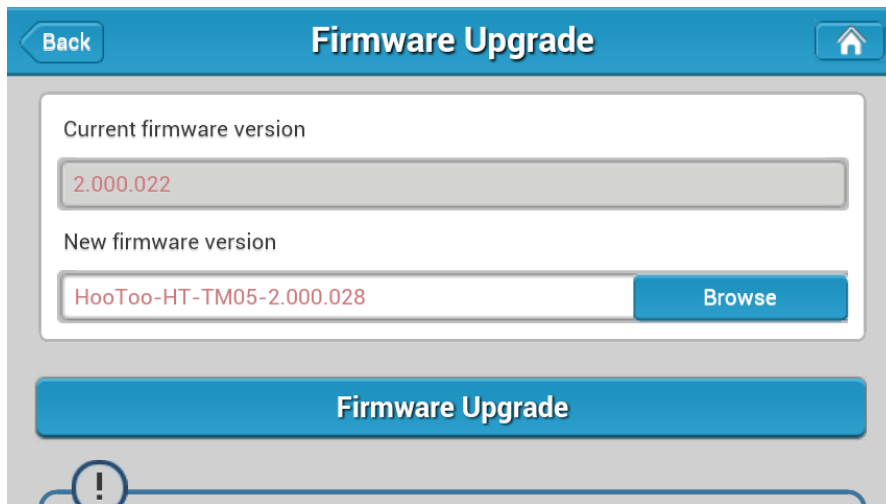
1. Download the firmware from the Hootoo website:  
<https://www.hootoo.com/downloads-81-88001-010.html#downloads-2000>
2. Unzip it and put it in your devices (Android device or Mac, Windows, but not iOS devices!)
3. Insert a USB storage device into your TripMate (e.g an external hard drive or a USB flash drive)
4. Connect to TripMate via wireless
5. Open a browser and enter 10.10.10.254
6. **Settings → System Settings → Firmware Upgrade → Browse**, Browse and select the exact file in your devices

7. Click **Firmware Upgrade**,



You will be prompted to wait 5 minutes while the system updates. After the system has updated, you will have successfully updated the firmware.

### **The second way:**

1. Please put the unzip-firmware in the root of your USB drive but not in any folders. (please note: our product just only support fat 16/fat32/ntfs/exfat format)
2. connect your devices (android devices/ios devices) to tripmate wireless
3. plug the USB drive on TripMate
4. **open the latest app (TripMate Plus)**
5. app would inform you it is upgrading the firmware automatically."
